### **SCHOOL HOURS**

School starts at 7:45 a.m. every day and ends as follows-

Learners must be dropped off and picked up from the parking area inside the 1<sup>st</sup> Road entrance. Please do **NOT** park in the driveway when dropping off children. **Proceed with utmost caution** while driving on the school property.

## **TUCKSHOP**

## **AFTERCARE**

An after care facility is offered on the school premises and takes place from 13h00 – 17h30 Monday to Friday. A small snack, i.e. Biscuits or popcorn and juice, will be provided for aftercare learners on arrival. Lunch is provided from 14h30 and a variety of activities are available to keep little ones occupied. Homework is also supervised for the older learners. Contact the office if you would like to send your child to aftercare.

## **TELEPHONE CALLS / PHOTOCOPYING**

Learners are not permitted to use the office phones, as there is a coin phone and card phone on the property for those "urgent" calls home. Please help keep school costs to a minimum by purchasing a phone card so that they can make use of the facility provided when items are left at home etc. A fee of R1 per A4 copy will be charged to learners who require personal photocopies to be made.

## **PARENTS' PRAYER GROUP**

A mother in the school heads up the mothers' group that meets weekly. There is also a fathers' group that meets monthly. This is a vital function of the school and parents are encouraged to join.
